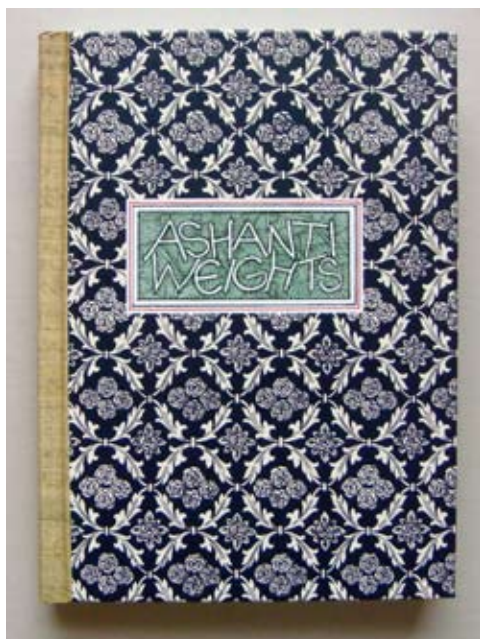


Ashanti Weights

Actual size facsimile of the artist's original notebook from the seventies in an edition of 300 signed and numbered copies.

To coincide with the publication of his *African Goldweights* Tom Phillips presents a facsimile of an original notebook of his pen and ink drawings made of Akan goldweights in the seventies.

Over a hundred and fifty drawings record early acquisitions accompanied by handwritten notes detailing the price he paid together with where and from whom he purchased them. This early selection of objects formed the nucleus of what was to become the world's most comprehensive collection now amply documented in *African Goldweights 1400 - 1900* (Edition Hansjorg Mayer, 220pp. Isbn 978-0500976968), available now in bookshops.

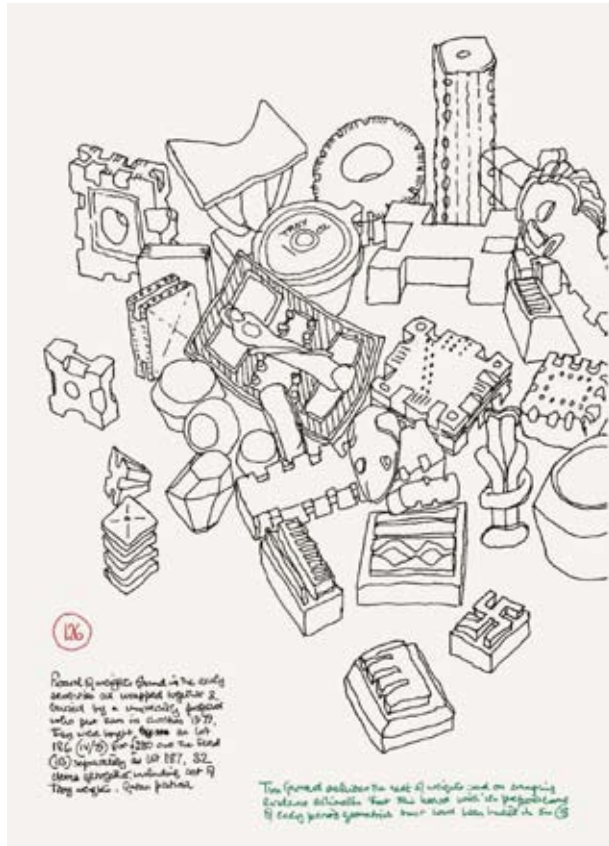
